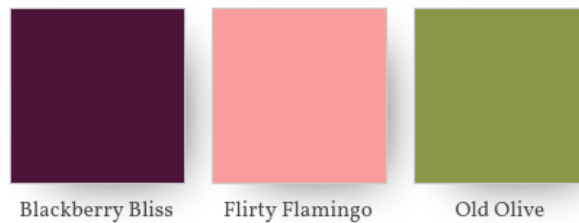


Project 3: Embossed



Recipe: Paper. Images. Embellishments.

The Color Palette:



Paper: Silver-edged tag, 2 strips of silver foil from envelope, leftover piece of vellum to use as a stencil

Images: Blissful Blooms stamp set & Blackberry Bliss Stampin' Spot

Embellishments: Baker's Twine in Flirty Flamingo with silver thread, 1 frosted leaf

Extras: Old Olive card stock, Shimmery White Embossing Paste, Palette Knife

The Project:

Step 1:

Cut your pieces.

- Old Olive card stock cut to 4 ¼" x 11" and score at 5 ½".

- Flirty Flamingo Baker's Twine: Cut 12" piece.
- Cut 2 strips $2\frac{3}{8}$ " long from the envelope that are $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide.

Step 2:

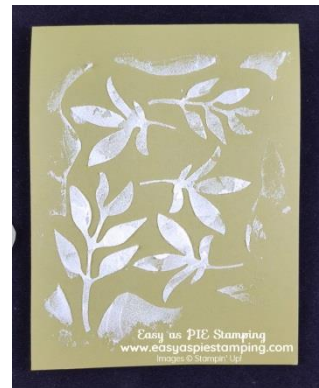
Stamp your images.

- Stamp the sentiment in Blackberry Bliss on the silver-edged tag.

Step 3:

Emboss.

- Cut a piece of the leftover vellum with 5 leaves to use as a stencil and round the outside edge. Spread a thin layer of embossing paste over the stencil making sure to fill in the leaves and let the paste go over the edges in some areas. Carefully pull the stencil up before the paste dries. **Tip:** Make sure to clean your tools immediately as the paste dries very quickly and is much more difficult to remove.



Step 4:

Putting it all together.

- Mount the silver foil pieces on the back side of the tag, on the right and left sides.
- Use glue dots to adhere the leaf to the back of the tag.
- Use Dimensionals to adhere the tag to the bottom right of the card front.
- Tie the Baker's Twine around the top of the card in knot.
